What He Suffers

- After He is condemned to die, Jesus' executioners gather to mock Him someone
- mock Him

• The cross was the most painful and miserable way the ancient world could develop to kill

• As Jesus is dying on the cross, various crowds

- based on what will give us the good life
- Love is at the center of Jesus' picture of the good life
- of the picture

• We don't act based on what we know; we act

 When Jesus envisions the good life, the ability to have a relationship with you is at the center
